3. Against the rejection of the claim of the petitioner for regularization by order dated 15.11.2021 under Annexure-6, which has been passed in compliance to the order dated 06.04.2021 in W.P.(C) No.12135 of 2021, the petitioner has approached this Court in the present writ application.

4. Issue notice.

5. Two extra copies of the writ petition be served on learned counsel for the State appearing for opposite parties 1 and 2 within three days, for enabling him to obtain instruction and file counter affidavit.

6. Requisites for issuance of notice to opposite party nos.3 and 4 by registered post with A.D. be filed within three days. The notice be issued fixing short returnable date.

7. List this matter along with W.P.(C) No. 2962 of 2022.
