ORDER

1. Heard learned counsel for the respective parties.
2. Instant petition under Section 482 BNSS is filed seeking pre-arrest bail of the petitioner in connection with G.R. Case No.2231 of 2025 pending in the file of learned J.M.F.C., Aska, Ganjam arising out of Gangapur Police Station bearing F.I.R No.649 of 2025 on the grounds stated.
3. Perused the FIR as at Annexure-2. The allegation is that the petitioner and co-accused persons assaulted the victim and caused injuries to him. Today, learned counsel for the State submits the medical examination report of the injured. From the said report, it reveals that the victim, namely, son of the informant received two lacerated wounds, one abrasion and bruise but all are stated to be simple in nature caused by a hard and blunt object. No specific overt act is alleged against the petitioner in the FIR. It has been an assault alleged against all



the accused persons. The petitioner is a student and was on interim protection till 25th March, 2026 by the Court's order in I.A. No.348 of 2026. In view of the above, recording the objection of the State and claim of absence of any other antecedent of the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to grant pre-arrest bail but is in favour of directing him to surrender before the learned court below for being released with stringent conditions and accordingly, it is ordered.

4. In the result, the ABLAPL is disposed of with the direction as aforesaid. In the event, the petitioner surrenders before the court of learned J.M.F.C., Aska, Ganjam within fortnight from today, it is directed that he shall be released on bail in connection with G.R. Case No.2231 of 2025 corresponding to Gangapur Police Station bearing F.I.R No.649 of 2025 on furnishing a bail bond of Rs.30,000/-(rupees thirty thousand) with one solvent surety for the like amount with such other conditions imposed as deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case besides the following, such as, he shall submit an undertaking at the local PS to not involve himself in similar activities while on bail and to report the I.O once in a fifteen days' time for the purpose of investigation, till it is over.
