1. Heard learned counsel for the respective parties.
2. Instant petition under Section 482 BNSS is filed for pre-arrest bail of the petitioner in connection with Kamarda P.S. Case No.44 of 2025 corresponding to C.T. Case No.158 of 2025 pending in the file of learned J.M.F.C., Bhograi on the grounds stated therein.
3. Perused the FIR as at Annexure-1. It is submitted to the Court by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the present accused is the brother-in-law of the deceased and the principal accused, namely, husband has been arrested in the meantime and is on bail. A copy of the bail order in respect of the husband of the deceased is at Annexure-3. The submission is that other accused persons are on bail and hence, the petitioner should also be released with conditions.
4. Recorded the objection of the State.



5. The petitioner had earlier approached this Court in ABLAPL No.4040 of 2025 disposed of on 1st May, 2025 and his plea for pre-arrest bail was declined. In the month of July, 2025, the principal accused was released on bail by the order of the learned court below. Considering the above facts and the submissions of the learned counsel for the respective parties and that, the petitioner is a disabled person, in support of which, a copy of Disability Certificate as at Annexure-2 is referred to, this Court considering the same though not inclined to grant pre-arrest bail to the petitioner but is of the view that he should be directed to surrender before the learned court below for being released on bail with suitable conditions.

6. Accordingly, it is ordered.

7. In the result, ABLAPL stands disposed of with the direction as aforesaid. It is further directed that in the event of surrender before the court of learned J.M.F.C., Bhograi within a fortnight from today, the petitioner shall be released on bail in connection with Kamarda P.S. Case No.44 of 2025 corresponding to C.T. Case No.158 of 2025 subject to him furnishing a bail bond of Rs.30,000/- (Rupees thirty thousand) with one solvent surety for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned court below, which shall be at liberty to impose such other suitable conditions as deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.
