01. 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and State.
2. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 BNSS by the petitioners seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with Baripada Town P.S. Case No.55 of 2026 corresponding to C.T. Case No.186 of 2026 pending in the court of learned S.D.J.M., Baripada on the grounds stated.
3. Perused the FIR as at Annexure-1. The names of the petitioners are mentioned in the FIR. The assault is allegedly by means of 'lathi' and 'kati' as a result of which, the victim said to have received bleeding injuries, which is revealed from Annexure-1. Recorded the submissions of learned counsel for the respective parties. In view of the involvement of the petitioners in the alleged incident and excess committed by them, this Court is not inclined to grant pre-arrest bail to them,



however, allows the liberty to surrender before the learned court below seeking regular bail.

4. Accordingly, it is ordered.

5. In the result, the ABLAPL is disposed of with the direction as aforesaid. It is further directed that in the event, the petitioners surrender within a fortnight from today before learned S.D.J.M., Baripada in connection with Baripada Town P.S. Case No.55 of 2026 corresponding to C.T. Case No.186 of 2026 and move regular bail, it shall be duly considered and in case rejected during the first hour, they may approach the learned Sessions Court during the second hour for orders on the same day.
