01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner. Perused the CMP application as well as the prayer made therein.
3. By filing the present application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, the Petitioner seeks to challenge order dated 26.12.2025 by the learned Civil Judge (Jr. Division), Soro, whereby the prayer of the plaintiff under Section 151 of CPC has been allowed and a direction has been reviewed to the local Police to implement the order of status quo passed in I.A. No.61 of 2012.
4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner at the outset contended that although there is no finding with regard to the violation of status quo order, however, the learned trial Court has passed an order granting liberty to the Opposite Party to seek police protection for enforcement of the status quo order.



5. Upon hearing of the learned counsel for the Petitioner, this Court is of the view that the matter requires further hearing in presence of the Opposite Party.

6. Hence, issue notice to the Opposite Party by Registered Post/Speed Post with A.D. by fixing a short returnable date. Requisites be filed within three working days.

7. List this matter in the week commencing 23.03.2026.

9. Accept one set of process fee.

10. It is clarified that the Petitioner shall not be unnecessarily harassed unless a clear case of violation of the status quo order is made out against the present Petitioner.
