1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. This writ petition has been filed with the following prayer:

“ Therefore, it is prayed that this Hon'ble Court be graciously pleased to admit the writ application, issue rule NISI in the nature of writ of mandamus or any other writ/writs as deem fit and proper calling upon the opposite parties to show-cause as to why the letter dated 06.01.2021 vide Annexure-7 and all actions pursuant thereto including formation of Non-Hereditary Trust Board in respect of Shree Gorekhnath Mahaprabhu bije at Kerkera under Tirtol Police Station under Jagatsinghpur district shall not be quashed/ set aside and why the interim trust board which is managing the affair of the deity shall not be renewed or alternatively why New Hereditary Trust Board shall not be formed after complying due process of law.

And further be pleased to pass any order/orders direction/directions as deem fit and proper.

And for this act of kindness the petitioner shall as in duty bound ever pray.”

3. It is submitted by Mr. Mohanta, learned counsel for the Petitioner that in the meantime, the Interim Trust Board of the deity has already been constituted. Hence, the writ petition has become infructuous. He also files a memo in support of his submission, which is taken on record.



4. In view of the submission of Mr. Mohanta, learned counsel for the Petitioner, the writ petition is disposed of as infructuous.

5. Interim order dated 9th February, 2021 passed in IA No.1516 of 2021 stands vacated.
