1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. The appellant-petitioners have filed I.A. No. 244 of 2026 under Rule-22(2) of the Orissa Motor Vehicles (Accident Claims Tribunal) Rules, 1960 (in short, "the Rules") for exemption from paying of Court fee for time being.
3. Heard learned counsel for the appellants and perused the record.
4. For the reasons stated therein in the IA, the prayer for exemption of payment of Court fee for the time being stands allowed, but the appellants-petitioners are, however, required to pay the Court fee after disposal of this appeal. Accordingly, the I.A. No. 244 of 2026 stands disposed of.
5. The present Interlocutory Application in I.A. No. 243 of 2026 U/S.5 of the Limitation Act, 1963 has been filed by the appellants-petitioners to condone the delay in preferring the appeal.



6. Heard. Issue notice on the question of hearing on admission and limitation against Respondents/OPs through Speed Post with AD by fixing a short returnable date. Requisites for issuance of notice to the Respondents/OPs shall be filed within three working days. Accept one set of process fee. List this matter on 15<sup>th</sup> May, 2026.
