4. Issue Notice.
5. Learned counsel for the State waives notice on behalf of the Opposite Party No.1. Let an extra copy of the brief be served on him within three working days hence. He is directed to file reply within two weeks from the date of receipt of the brief.
6. Notice be issued to the Opposite Party No.2/informant by Speed Post with A.D. making it returnable by 20th February,



2026. Requisites for issuance of notice shall be filed within three working days hence.

7. List this matter on 25th February, 2026.

8. In the meantime, learned counsel for the Petitioner shall explore the possibility of an amicable settlement between the parties and, if arrived at, file a compromise affidavit to that effect.
