Order No.

01. 1. Both the ABLAPLs are taken up for orders.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner in ABLAPL No.7129 of 2026 submits that the said accused has not been named in the FIR. As to the other petitioner in ABLAPL No.1331 of 2026, it is informed to the Court by the learned counsel appearing for him that he was falsely framed and for a criminal case was registered at the instance of the informant and was in custody for some days, hence, he could not attend the mediation, but it



is opposed and denied by the learned counsel for the informant claiming that he did not attend the mediation at all and on being asked, learned counsel for the said petitioner informs the Court that the custody of the accused was not intimated to the Mediator and thereafter, the proceeding was closed. Since mediation is over and the same is unsuccessful, considering the nature of allegations made, this Court is not inclined to entertain the bail plea of the petitioners in ABLAPL No.1331 of 2026, however, granting liberty to them to surrender before the court below seeking regular bail and in case of rejection, to approach the learned Sessions Court. As to the other case in ABLAPL No.7129 of 2026, it is stated by the parties that the summons was issued by the local PS against the petitioner, but no allegation has been made against him in the FIR and he is even not named therein and considering the same, this Court is inclined to allow him to go on bail in the event of arrest by the Arresting Officer subject to condition.

3. The ABLAPLs are disposed of. In the event of arrest of the petitioner in ABLAPL No.7129 of 2026 in connection with G.R Case No.103 of 2026 corresponding to Cuttack Sadar P.S. Case No.56 of 2026 of the learned J.M.F.C (R), Cuttack, it is directed by this Court that he shall be released on bail by the Arresting Officer on furnishing a bail bond of Rs.15,000/- (rupees fifteen thousand) with one solvent surety for the like amount. With respect to the petitioners in ABLAPL No.1331 of 2026, in view of the liberty granted to them, they may avail the same and surrender before the learned court below within a fortnight from today in connection with G.R Case No.103 of 2026 seeking regular bail. In case of such surrender and



application is moved demanding release on bail, it shall be duly considered by the court concerned in the first hour and in case of rejection, they shall approach the learned Sessions Court demanding release and for orders during the second hour. For the said purpose, the lower court record shall be made available to the Sessions Court at the time of hearing.

4. Consequently, the interim order passed in ABLPL No.1331 of 2026 stands vacated.
