1. Perused the FIR as at Annexure-1. The case diary and statements of the witnesses recorded under Section 180 BNSS are produced and also the PM report of the deceased. Mr. Dash, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the deceased had a suicidal hanging and not homicidal. It is informed to the Court that the petitioner is working as DGM in a company, in which, the deceased was an employee. The Court is inclined to ascertain the cause of death as to whether the deceased committed suicide as is claimed by the petitioner and hence, requests Miss Sahu, learned AGA for the State to take instructions and to reply back.

2. List on 31st March, 2026 for further orders and in the meantime, this Court, as an interim measure, considering the materials on record especially the statements of the witnesses recorded under Section 180 BNSS claiming therein that the



deceased committed suicide, directs that the petitioner shall not be taken into custody in connection with Bhawanipatna Town P.S. Case No.28 of 2026 corresponding to C.T. Case No.47 of 2026 pending in the file of learned S.D.J.M., Bhawanipatna till the next date of hearing.
