This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

**2.** The present writ petition has been preferred by the Petitioners for inaction of the Tahasildar, Kamakhyanagar (Opposite Party No.2), and the I.I.C., Tumusingha P.S. (Opposite Party No.3) to act in terms of the order dated 20.09.2024 passed by the Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Kamakhyanagar (Opposite Party No.1) in Criminal Misc. Case No.23 of 2023 under Section 133 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

**3.** In view of the allegations made in the writ petition, regarding inaction of Opposite Party Nos.1 to 3, since there are specific provisions under the Code of Criminal Procedure for implementation of an order passed under Section 133 of the Cr.P.C., the Petitioners may move appropriate application before the Sub-Collector-cum-Sub



Divisional Magistrate, Kamakhyanagar for implementation of its order dated 20.09.2024 passed in Criminal Misc. Case No.23 of 2023, if so advised.

4. Accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed of.
5. It is made clear that if such an application is moved, Opposite Party No.1 shall do well to deal with and dispose of the same in accordance with law at the earliest, preferably within a period of two months from the date of filing of such application.
