01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard Mr. S.S.Das, learned Senior Counsel for the Petitioner. Perused the writ application as well as the prayer made therein.
3. By filing the present writ application, the Petitioner calls in question the legality and validity of order dated 16.07.2025 under Annexure-27 of the writ application.
4. Learned Senior Counsel appearing for the Petitioner, at the outset, contended that the Petitioner had earlier approached this Court by filing W.P.(C) No.33148 of 2023, which was disposed of by a Coordinate Bench vide order dated 30.01.2024, granting liberty to the Petitioner to move an application before the Opposite Party No.1 for redressal of his grievance in a time bound manner. He further



submitted that after disposal of the earlier writ application, the Petitioner approach the Opposite Party No.1 by filing an application, which has been disposed of by the impugned order dated 29.08.2025 at Annexure-28, thereby rejecting the claim of the Petitioner.

5. Having heard the learned Senior Counsel for the Petitioner and on a careful examination of the impugned order, this Court is of the view that the matter requires further examination after filing of the counter affidavit.

6. Hence, issue notice to the Opposite Parties. Four Extra copies of the writ application be served on Mr. P.K.Parhi, learned DSGI, who usually appears of the Opposite Parties.

7. Counter affidavit, if any, be filed within a period of six weeks.

8. Rejoinder affidavit, if any, be filed within two weeks thereafter.

9. Lis this matter in the week commencing 6th July, 2026.
