1. Heard.
2. This appeal has been filed challenging the judgment dated 26.12.2025 passed by the learned Special Judge (Vigilance), Bhubaneswar in TR Case No. 37 of 2010 arising out of Bhubaneswar Vigilance PS Case No. 32 of 2006 convicting the appellant for commission of offences punishable under Section 13(2) read with Section 13(1)(c) of the P.C. Act, 1988 and 420,468,471,120-B of the IPC and sentencing him there under. The appellant has been sentenced to undergo RI for 3 years and to pay fine of Rs.25,000/- and in default of payment of fine to undergo RI for another 3 months for the offence punishable under Section 13(2) of the P.C. Act, 1988 and each of the offences under Section 420,468,471,120-B of the IPC. There is a direction for the sentences to run concurrently.
3. Admit.
