1. Heard learned counsel for the respective parties.
2. Instant petition under Section 482 BNSS is filed for pre-arrest bail of the petitioners in connection with Kamarda P.S. Case No. 101 of 2020 corresponding to C.T. Case No.698 of 2020 pending in the file of learned Gramya Nyayalay-Cum-J.M.F.C., Bhograi on the grounds stated therein.
3. Perused the FIR as at Annexure-1. Referring to an affidavit of the informant filed before this Court, it is submitted by Mr. Jena, learned counsel that there is a compromise between the parties, hence, the petitioners should be allowed to go on bail with conditions. Mr. Pandit, learned counsel for the informant appears through virtual mode and confirms the fact of compromise. It is submitted that some of the accused persons are on bail pursuant to the order in ABLAPL No.12345 of 2020. A copy of the said order is at flag-A. Considering the aforesaid development and compromise having taken place between the parties, as it is made to reveal from the affidavit of the informant, this Court is inclined direct the petitioners to



surrender before the learned court below for being released with conditions even though not in favour of entertaining their plea of pre-arrest bail.

4. Accordingly, it is ordered.

5. In the result, the ABLAPL petition stands disposed of with a direction to the petitioners to surrender before learned Gramya Nyayalay-Cum-J.M.F.C., Bhograi within four weeks from today and in the event, they surrender in compliance thereof, shall be released on bail in connection with C.T. Case No.698 of 2020 arising out of Kamarda P.S. Case No. 101 of 2020 on furnishing a bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (rupees twenty thousand) each with one solvent surety for the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court below, which shall be at liberty to impose such other suitable conditions as deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case. It is further directed that such release of the petitioner shall be subject to verification regarding the compromise with a notice to the informant.
