01. 1. Heard learned counsel for the Parties.
2. By means of this application, the Petitioner seeks
the following prayer:-

“It is therefore prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be graciously pleased to issue Rule Nisi calling upon the Opp. Parties to show cause why the said Rule shall not be made Absolute.

Upon return thereto hear the parties and/or their counsel and for insufficient cause this Hon'ble Court may be further pleased to direct the Opp. Party Nos. 2 to 4 to execute the Orders of Non-Bailable Warrant of arrest and process u/s.82/83 of Cr.P.C against the Opp.Party No.5 issued by the Ld. J.M.F.C-III (Cog.Taking), Cuttack in I.C.C. Case No.02 of 2020 within a stipulated time as deem fit and proper by this Hon'ble Court for the interest of justice.”



3. The learned District and Sessions, Judge, Cuttack, is directed to examine the case in connection with 1.C.C. Case No. 02 of 2020 and furnish a report as to whether the court concerned has proceeded in accordance with law, following the established procedure under Sections 82-83 of the Cr.P.C., and recording its order in consonance with the GRCO in adhering to the provision under Sections 82 & 83 of the Cr.P.C. The report shall be furnished by the next date of the sitting of this Court.

4. Registrar (Judicial) of this Court is directed to communicate the order of this Court to the District and Sessions, Judge, Cuttack for compliance.

5. The Office is directed to place the record before the Registrar (Judicial) for necessary compliance.
