1. Heard learned counsel for the respective parties.
 2. This Court by order dated 27th February, 2026 had directed the learned District and Sessions Judge, Cuttack to examine the record in 1CC Case No.02 of 2020 and to report back, which has been received and at Flag-X and the same is gone through.
 3. Mr. Nayak, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the NBWA issued against opposite party No.5 still not executed and it was followed by proclamation and attachment order of the court of learned J.M.F.C.-III (Cog. Taking), Cuttack. In the meantime, this Court directed such a report to be submitted by learned District and Sessions Judge, Cuttack by its order dated 27th February, 2026.
 4. The report at Flag-X be kept in record.



5. Since limited grievance of the petitioner is about non-execution of NBWA directed against opposite party No.5 in 1CC Case No.02 of 2020 by order dated 2nd November, 2021 and, in the meanwhile, five years have gone by, this Court is inclined to fix a time-line for opposite party No.4 to ensure its execution without further delay.

6. Accordingly, it is ordered.

7. In the result, the CRLMP stands disposed of with the direction as aforesaid for compliance by opposite party No.4 soon after receiving a copy of this order to ensure early execution of NBWA issued against opposite party No.5 by the learned J.M.F.C.-III (Cog. Taking), Cuttack in 1CC Case No.02 of 2020 preferably within period of three weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

8. Issue urgent certified copy of this order as per rules.

9. A copy to the State for intimation to opposite party No.4 for early compliance.
