1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. Mr. Manas Kumar Chand, learned counsel for the petitioner prays to grant interim bail to the petitioner for two months, but this bail application was filed on 30.01.2026 and therefore, two months period is already over. Further, it is found from the impugned order that interim bail was not sought for for the petitioner in the learned trial Court. In the aforesaid facts and circumstances, this Court does not consider it proper to grant interim bail to the petitioner with the situation prevailing as on 30.01.2026, however, grants liberty to the petitioner to approach the Court in seisin over the matter afresh for the self-same relief with fresh medical documents and in that event the learned trial Court shall pass appropriate order in accordance with law, if there is no other legal impediment.
3. Accordingly, the present bail application stands disposed of with aforesaid liberty.
