Order No.

03. 1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State and learned counsel for the Opposite Party Nos.3 and 4.
2. The present writ application has been filed alleging in action in the matter of issuance of Land Right Certificate (LRC), to which the Petitioner is stated to be entitled to.
3. Referring to the communication received from the Opposite Party Nos.3 and 4 (Bhubaneswar Municipal Corporation) under the RTI Act relating to the grievance of the Petitioner on account of non-receipt of such LRC stated to be under "Jaga Mission",



it is submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioner that since the matter is admittedly under process, the authorities may be directed to issue the same within a time frame.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the Opposite Party Nos.3 and 4 submits that instead of awaiting for issuance of the same, the Petitioner has rushed to this Court. As such, the writ petition is not maintainable.

5. Considering the rival submission, this Court is persuaded to hold that the interest of justice would be sub served, if the Opposite Party Nos.3 and 4 are called upon to dispose of the grievance of the Petitioner in terms of the RTI reply dated 06.12.2025 that issuance of such LRC which is under process within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt/production of this order along with a copy of this writ petition.

6. Accordingly, the W.P.(C) stands disposed of.
