2. By means of this application, the Petitioner seeks to challenge the order dated 28.11.2025 passed by the learned Judge, Family Court-II, Bhubaneswar, in Criminal Execution No.100 of 2024 arising out of CRP No.49 of 2012, wherein the learned court declined to grant the relief prayed for by the Petitioner by stopping the payment directed under Section 125 Cr.P.C. in favor of the daughter. However, the court, while so declining has allowed liberty to the Petitioner to file a Petition under Section 127 Cr.P.C to deal with the grievance in accordance with law.
3. Learned counsel for the Petitioner, in course of the hearing, while registered the impugned order, subsequently |
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with all fairness submitted that Petitioner would resort to the liberty given by the learned court by filing an application under Section 127 Cr.P.C and as such does not press for this application. The same is accepted and the Petition, being not pressed, is allowed to be withdrawn and disposed of accordingly. The petitioner is at liberty to move the concerned court in an application under Section 127 Cr.P.C. for redressal of his grievance, if any.

4. Accordingly, the CRLMP stands disposed of.
