1. Heard learned counsel for the respective parties.
2. Instant petition under Section 482 BNSS is filed for pre-arrest bail of the petitioners in connection with P.R. No. 383/2025-26, dated 07.01.2026 of OIC of S.I. of Excise District Mobile Unit, Balasore corresponding to 2(a)CC No. 18 of 2026 pending in the file of Learned J.M.F.C, Soro, Balasore on the grounds stated therein
3. Perused the FIR as at Annexuer-1 and it reveals that 2000 liters of I.D. liquor was seized from the petitioners, which is disputed by learned counsel for the petitioners on the ground that the same is not quite possible.
4. Recorded the objection of the State. Learned counsel for the State submits that the petitioners are involved in possession of the huge quantity of I.D. liquor and hence, are not entitled to bail.



5. Considering the submissions as above and the P.R., i.e., Annexuer-1, this Court is not inclined to grant pre-arrest bail to the petitioners, however, is of the view that they should be directed to surrender before the court concerned seeking bail.

6. Accordingly, it is ordered.

7. In the result, ABLAPL is disposed of. It is further directed that in the event, the petitioners surrender within a period of fifteen days from today before the learned Learned J.M.F.C, Soro, Balasore in connection with P.R. No. 383/2025-26, dated 07.01.2026 of OIC of S.I. of Excise District Mobile Unit, Balasore corresponding to 2(a)CC No. 18 of 2026 and move applications for regular bail, it shall be duly considered in the first hour and in case of rejection, they shall approach the learned Sessions Court during the second hour for orders on the same day followed by a decision on merit and for the said purpose, the case record shall be made available.
