1. Heard learned counsel for the respective parties.
2. Considering the request, the bail plea vis-a-vis petitioner No.1 is not pressed, hence, the ABLAPL is dismissed as against him.
3. Instant petition under Section 482 BNSS is filed for pre-arrest bail of petitioner No.2 in connection with Sundargarh Town P.S. Case No.29 of 2026 corresponding to G.R. Case No.103 of 2026 pending in the file of learned S.D.J.M., Sundargarh on the grounds stated therein.
4. In view of the common order in ABLAPL No.1173 of 2026 and batch of cases, this Court is inclined to release petitioner No.2 on similar terms and conditions.
5. Accordingly, it is ordered.



6. In the result, ABLAPL stands disposed of with the direction as aforesaid. It is further directed that in the event, petitioner No.2 surrenders before the court of learned S.D.J.M., Sundargarh within a fortnight from today, he shall be released on bail in connection with Sundargarh Town P.S. Case No.29 of 2026 corresponding to G.R. Case No.103 of 2026 subject to him furnishing a bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with one solvent surety for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned court below, which shall be at liberty to impose such other suitable conditions as deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case with an additional condition that he shall not involve himself in any such similar antecedent after being released.
