01. 1. This CRLMP has been filed for a direction to the Opposite Parties to proceed with the case within a stipulated time against the accused persons in G.R. Case No. 777 of 2025.
2. It has been alleged by the Petitioner that he was the President of the Board of Revenue Bar Association in the year 2023-24 and 2024-25 and one Gyanendra Kumar Parida was the Secretary. Mr. Pradhan has withdrawn the fixed deposits and made payments to different persons by issuing cheques without knowledge of the Petitioner and also forged the signature of the Petitioner on the cheques.



3. Mr. Durga Prasad Jena, learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that although Lalbag P.S. Case No. 344 of 2025 was registered on 29.08.2025 on the complaint of the Petitioner, but the investigation in the case is not proceeding in accordance with law. Till date the resolution book and cheque books have not been seized by the Police from the accused, for which the Petitioner apprehends their further misuse.

4. Considering the nature of allegations and the apprehension of the Petitioner, the CRLMP is disposed of directing the I.O. to complete the investigation expeditiously which is to be supervised by the I.I.C., Lalbag Police Station if he is not the I.O. in the case.
