1. Heard Mr.Rout, learned counsel for the Petitioner and Mr.Tripathy, learned Additional Government Advocate for the State-Opposite Party.
2. The limited grievance of the Petitioner is that despite the direction of the learned C.J.M., Khurda passed in Misc.Case No.243 of 2023 in terms of Section 14 of the SARFAESI Act, the Opposite Party is not taking any step on the same.

Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of at the stage of admission with a direction to the Opposite Party to take steps on the direction of the learned C.J.M., Khurda under Annexure-1, in accordance with law, if there is no other legal impediment, within a period of four weeks from the date of
