1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the guidelines of PMAY 'family' has been defined to include husband, wife and unmarried son and daughter (major and minor) and once son or daughter gets married their family will be separated.
3. In the present context, the claim of the petitioner appears to have been disallowed on the ground that out of her five sons two have availed benefits under the PMAY Scheme. However, it is not disputed that all her five sons are married.
4. Under such circumstances, the State counsel shall obtain instructions as regards applicability of the guidelines to the petitioner's case. If necessary a further affidavit be filed.
