1. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel appearing for the parties.
3. Pursuant to order dt.13.02.2026, learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner contended that in fact the Transformer is being placed over Plot No.1722 and not over Plot No.1723, as contended by the learned counsel appearing for the TPCODL.
4. Considering the nature of order passed by this Court on 13.02.2026 basing on the instruction of the learned counsel appearing for the TPCODL that the transformer is being installed over Plot No.1723, which is now disputed by the Petitioner by saying that it is being installed over Plot No.1722, this Court in exercise of its power under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, cannot go into all these disputed question facts.



5. In this view of the matter, it is open for the Petitioner to approach before the appropriate Court of law for consideration of his grievance.

6. With the aforesaid liberty, the Writ Petition stands disposed of.
