This criminal appeal has been filed by the convicted accused-appellant against the judgment and order of conviction dated 30th January, 2026, passed by the learned 3rd Additional Sessions Judge, Bhubaneswar in Crl. Trial Case No.112 of 2019, arising out of C.T. Case No.268 of 2019. By the said judgment, the appellant has been convicted under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code and sentenced to undergo imprisonment for life and to pay a fine of ₹20,000/-(Rupees Twenty Thousand), in default of payment of fine, to undergo further period of sentence of rigorous imprisonment for 2 (two) years.
2. Heard Mr. S.K. Lenka, learned counsel appearing for the appellant and Mr. D. Mohanty, learned Additional Government Advocate for the respondent-State.
3. Admit this appeal.
4. Call for the scanned copy of the Trial Court Records of Crl. Trial Case No.112 of 2019 from the Court of the learned 3rd Additional Sessions Judge, Bhubaneswar.



5. Learned Counsel for the State shall apprise the Court on the next date of listing regarding the criminal antecedents of the convict-appellant as well as her conduct in jail.

6. By the next date of listing, learned counsel for the State shall also obtain the scanned copy of the relevant Case Diary as well as the Custody Certificate of the appellant.

7. List this matter in the week commencing from 27th April, 2026.

8. Heard learned counsel appearing for the parties.

9. There shall be stay of realization of the fine imposed on the appellant-petitioner by the learned 3rd Additional Sessions Judge, Bhubaneswar vide judgment dated 30th January, 2026 passed in CrI. Trial Case No.112 of 2019, pending disposal of this appeal.
