01. 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and State.
2. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 BNSS by the petitioners seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with Boudh P.S. Case No.9 of 2026 corresponding to C.T. Case No.10 of 2026 pending in the court of learned S.D.J.M., Boudh on the grounds stated.
3. Perused the FIR as at Annexure-1. Recorded the submissions of learned counsel for the respective parties. As per the FIR, the principal accused named therein was in relationship with the informant and it was on a promise of marriage. The alleged mischief is directed against the son of petitioner Nos.1 and 2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are alleged of having committed offences punishable under Sections 69, 296 and 3(5) BNSS. It



is submitted that the principal accused has been arrested in the meantime for the alleged mischief committed by him. The report reveals that the parents and also petitioner No.3 who happens to be the brother of the principal accused abused the informant and threatened her with dire consequences. Considering the nature of allegation alleged against the petitioners, who are family members of the principal accused already arrested and recording the objection of the State, this Court is of the view that even if it is not a case for pre-arrest bail but all of them should be directed to surrender before the learned court below for being released with conditions and accordingly, it is ordered.

4. In the result, the ABLAPL is disposed of with the direction as aforesaid. It is further directed that in the event, the petitioners surrender before the court of learned S.D.J.M., Boudh in connection with Boudh P.S. Case No.9 of 2026 corresponding to C.T. Case No.10 of 2026 within a fortnight from today, they shall be released on bail upon furnishing bail bonds of Rs.20,000/-(rupees twenty thousand) each with one solvent surety for the like amount each with other conditions imposed besides the following, such as, they shall not commit any further mischief involving the informant and cause any harm to her in any manner whatsoever, while on bail and to co-operate the IO in the investigation, till its completion.
