1. Heard learned counsel for the respective parties.
2. Instant petition under Section 482 BNSS is filed for pre-arrest bail of the petitioners in connection with Brahmagiri P.S. Case No.13 of 2026 corresponding to G.R.G.N. Case No.15 of 2026 pending in the file of learned Nyayadhikari Gramanyalaya, Brahmagiri on the grounds stated therein.
3. Perused the FIR as at Annexuer-1 and it reveals that the principal accused misbehaved the police staff and hence, the report has been lodged. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the principal accused is the son of the petitioners, who have not committed any excess during incident. Admittedly, the allegation in the FIR relates to the accused, namely, Tapu Jena, who is the son of the petitioners and did the overt acts. Considering the above facts and submissions of learned counsel for the respective parties, this Court though not inclined to grant pre-arrest bail to the petitioners, however, is of the view that they should be directed



to surrender before the learned court below for being released on bail with suitable conditions imposed.

4. Accordingly, it is ordered.

5. In the result, the ABLAPL is disposed of. It is directed that in the event, the petitioners surrender within a fortnight from today before the learned Nyayadhikari Gramanyalaya, Brahmagiri in connection with Brahmagiri P.S. Case No.13 of 2026 corresponding to G.R.G.N. Case No.15 of 2026, they shall be released on bail subject to them on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand) each with one solvent surety for the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below, which shall be at liberty to impose such other suitable conditions as deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.
