1. The cause title be corrected in view of memo filed today with regard to the name of the Court as J.M.F.C.-V, Bhubaneswar.

2. Heard learned counsel for the respective parties.

3. Instant petition under Section 482 BNSS is filed for pre-arrest bail of the petitioners in connection with Khandagiri P.S. Case No.24 of 2026 corresponding to C.T. Case No.87 of 2026 pending in the file of learned J.M.F.C.-V, Bhubaneswar on the grounds stated therein.

4. Perused the FIR as at Annexuer-1. The victim was assaulted by the accused persons during the alleged incident by means of slaps and kicks and he was said to be admitted in AIIMS, Bhubaneswar. Mr. Bhanjadeo, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioner has been discharged from the hospital after treatment and another accused, namely, Kalia @ Krishna Reddy was released on bail pursuant to the Court's order in ABLAPL No.1301 of 2026. The further submission is



that there has been no serious injury received by the victim. And that apart, the petitioners are similarly situated. Learned AGA for the State produced a copy of the dying declaration in respect of the injured dated 14th January, 2026, but in response to the same, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that such statement was recorded in anticipation of his death but he was discharged from the hospital after treatment. Considering the submissions of learned counsel for the respective parties and since the co-accused above named has been released on bail subject to verification and absence of grievous injury received by the victim, this Court is inclined to extend parity to them and accordingly, it is ordered.

5. In the result, the ABLAPL is disposed of. It is directed that in the event, the petitioners surrender within a fortnight from today before the learned J.M.F.C.-V, Bhubaneswar in connection with Khandagiri P.S. Case No.24 of 2026 corresponding to C.T. Case No.87 of 2026, they shall be released on bail subject to them on furnishing a bail bond of Rs.30,000/- (Rupees thirty thousand) each with one solvent surety for the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below, which shall be at liberty to impose such other suitable conditions as deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case, besides the following, such as, they shall not cause any harm to the informant and her husband, while on bail.

6. Issue urgent certified copy as per rules.
