01.           1.       Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and State.
2.       Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 BNSS by the petitioner seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with Bharatpur P.S. Case No.104 of 2025 corresponding to C.T. Case No.304 of 2025 pending in the court of learned J.M.F.C., (Cog-V), Bhubaneswar on the grounds stated.
3.       Gone through the FIR as at Annexure-1. It is submitted that the petitioner committed the excess under the influence of alcohol. The further submission is that the assault was by means of a key and for that, the informant received a head injury but not serious. Recorded the objection of the State. It is informed to the Court that the petitioner is having two other criminal cases to his credit. But having regard to the fact that there is no any grievous injury said to have been caused to the informant as claimed and the manner of assault described in the



FIR, this Court recording the objection of the State, is inclined to direct him to surrender before the learned court below, as it is not case of pre-arrest bail, for being released with suitable conditions imposed.

4. Accordingly, it is ordered.

5. In the result, the ABLAPL is disposed of with the direction as aforesaid. It is directed that in the event, the petitioner surrenders before the learned J.M.F.C., (Cog-V), Bhubaneswar in connection with Bharatpur P.S. Case No.104 of 2025 corresponding to C.T. Case No.304 of 2025 within a fortnight from today, he shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bail bond of Rs.30,000/-(rupees thirty thousand) with one solvent surety for the like amount with other conditions besides the following, such as, he shall not cause any harm to the informant, while on bail and to attend the PS once in a fortnight for investigation, till it is over.
