1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
 2. None appears for the Petitioners at the time of call.
 3. The Petitioner has made the following prayer:-
*“It is humbly prayed that this Hon'ble Court may graciously be pleased to Issue Rule Nisi calling upon the opp.parties to show cause as to why the orders dated 29.12.2025 and 13.01.2026 shall not be quashed and in case the Opp. Parties do not show cause or shows insufficient or wrong cause the Hon ble Court may make the rule absolute by quashing the same; and direct transfer of O.A. No. 1/2022 to another Assistant Commissioner of Endowments or any other authority having similar Jurisdiction:
Pass such other order(s) as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the interest of justice;”*
 4. Keeping in mind the allegations made against the Additional Assistant Commissioner of Endowments, Cuttack, this Court directed the learned Counsel representing the Additional Assistant Commissioner of Endowments, Cuttack to take instruction in the matter.



5. In the meantime, the Officer, who is functioning as Additional Assistant Commissioner of Endowments, Cuttack has already tendered his resignation. Thus, no cause of action survives to entertain the writ petition.

6. Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed.
