01. 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and State.
2. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 BNSS by the petitioner seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with Kalinganagar (Duburi) P.S. Case No.451 of 2025 corresponding to C.T. Case No.735 of 2025 pending in the court of learned GN-cum-J.M.F.C., Sukinda on the grounds stated.
3. Perused the FIR as at Annexure-1. It is submitted to the Court by Mr. Mishra, learned counsel for the petitioner that the present accused is having no antecedent but stands implicated on the basis of the confessional statements of the co-accused persons, who are on bail at present. It is claimed that the petitioner was engaged to load the copper cable, which was left behind. It is further submitted that it was an attempt to commit theft of the cable and that apart, when the petitioner is having no antecedent, he should be allowed to go on bail as in the



meantime, the co-accused persons have been released. Recorded the objection of the State. The FIR reveals that the cable could not be removed from site and the accused persons left it and escaped. The report reveals that unknown miscreants committed the mischief. In view of the above and since the petitioner's involvement is claimed on the basis of disclosure made by the arrested co-accused persons, this Court, recording the objection of the State, though not inclined to grant pre-arrest bail to the petitioner but is of the view that he should surrender before the learned court below for being released with conditions subject to absence of antecedent against him.

4. Accordingly, it is ordered.

5. In the result, the ABLAPL is disposed of with the direction as aforesaid. It is further directed that in the event, the petitioner surrenders before the court of learned GN-cum-J.M.F.C., Sukinda in connection with Kalinganagar (Duburi) P.S. Case No.451 of 2025 corresponding to C.T. Case No.735 of 2025 within a fortnight from today, he shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bail bond of Rs.30,000/-(rupees thirty thousand) with one solvent surety for the like amount subject to compliance of as above with other conditions as deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.
