1. Heard learned counsel for the respective parties.
2. Instant petition under Section 482 BNSS is filed for pre-arrest bail of the petitioners in connection with Kujang P.S. Case No.21 of 2026 corresponding to G.R. Case No.72 of 2026 pending in the file of learned J.M.F.C.(P), Kujang on the grounds stated therein.
3. Perused the FIR as at Annexuer-1. The offences are bailable in nature, hence, the ABLAPL is not maintainable, however, considering the submission of learned counsel for the petitioners that there is apprehension of arrest during investigation for a higher offence and recording the objection of the State, this Court is inclined to direct the petitioners to surrender before the learned court below for being released on bail with conditions.
4. Accordingly, it is ordered.



4. In the result, the ABLAPL is disposed of. It is directed that in the event, the petitioners surrender within a fortnight from today before the learned J.M.F.C.(P), Kujang in connection with Kujang P.S. Case No.21 of 2026 corresponding to G.R. Case No.72 of 2026, they shall be released on bail subject to them on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand) each with one solvent surety for the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below, which shall be at liberty to impose such other suitable conditions as deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.
