1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. As directed, learned State Counsel obtained instruction from the Tahasildar, Balasore, who has submitted a letter in writing addressed to the learned Advocate General on 30.06.2025, inter alia, stating his difficulties for not being able to furnish the required instruction with request for grant of one month time. It is to be noted that the order requiring him to furnish the required instruction was passed way back on 11.09.2024 and in the meantime, more than nine months have elapsed. The grounds cited by the Tahasildar are not acceptable to say the least.
3. Learned State Counsel however requests that some further time be granted in the interest of justice.
4. Two weeks' time is granted for the purpose.
5. List this matter on 16th July, 2025, on which date the Tahasildar, Balasore shall appear in person with the required instruction for being produced before this Court.
