1. Heard learned counsel for the respective parties.
2. Instant petition under Section 482 BNSS is filed seeking pre-arrest bail of the petitioner in connection with Nimapada P.S. Case No.244 of 2022 corresponding to G.R. Case No.671 of 2022 pending in the file of learned J.M.F.C. Nimapara on the grounds stated.
3. Perused the FIR as at Annexure-1. The Court finds that a case has been registered after a complaint filed by the informant, namely, brother of the deceased. It is submitted to the Court that the deceased was having a one-sided love with the petitioner, to which, she did not agree and thereafter, he committed suicide. It is made to understand that the deceased consumed poison and committed suicide. The petitioner is a woman aged about 27 years and she has been implicated on the basis the complaint filed registered for an offence under



Section 304 IPC. This Court considering the above facts and submissions of learned counsel for the respective parties and since, the deceased consumed poison and it a case of suicidal death and there has been release of three other accused persons vide ABLAPL No.7575 of 2025 dated 13th August, 2025, recording the objection of the State, this Court is inclined to allow her to go on bail after surrender instead of entertaining any such plea for pre-arrest bail as has been advanced.

4. Accordingly, it is ordered.

5. In the result, the ABLAPL is disposed of with the direction as aforesaid. In the event, the petitioner surrenders before the court of learned J.M.F.C. Nimapara within fortnight from today, it is directed that she shall be released on bail in connection with Nimapada P.S. Case No.244 of 2022 corresponding to G.R. Case No.671 of 2022 on furnishing a bail bond of Rs.20,000/-(rupees twenty thousand) with one solvent surety for the like amount with such other conditions imposed as deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.
