1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. This is a bail application U/S.483 of the BNSS by the petitioner for grant of bail in connection with STF CID CB Bhubaneswar PS Case No.17 of 2025 corresponding to GR(Spl.) Case No.19 of 2025 pending in the Court of learned Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Cuttack for commission of offences punishable U/Ss.21(C)/29 of the NDPS Act, on the main allegation of possessing & transporting 26,658 number of 100ml. bottles of WINCEREX Cough Syrup containing Codeine Phosphate and Triprolidine Hydrochloride.
3. Heard, Mr. Amulya Ratna Panda, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. P. Satapathy, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor in the matter and perused the record.
4. After having considered the rival submissions and taking into consideration the nature and gravity of the offence as alleged against the Petitioner vis-à-vis



the accusation sought to be brought against him and regard being had to the recovery and seizure of such huge quantity of cough syrup containing Contraband article which is coming under commercial quantity allegedly from the possession of the petitioner and at his instance and keeping in view his failure to satisfy the conditions of Sec. 37 of NDPS Act which is sine qua non for grant of bail to an accused for commission of an offence under NDPS Act involving commercial quantity, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

5. Hence, the bail application of the petitioner stands rejected. Accordingly, the BLAPL stands disposed of. A copy of this order be immediately communicated to the learned trial Court.
