1. Since these two bail applications arise out of one and same case record, the same are heard together and disposed of by this common order with the consent of the learned counsel for the parties.

2. These are the bail applications U/S.483 of BNSS by the petitioners for grant of bail in connection with GR Case No. 60 of 2026 arising out of B.N. Pur PS Case No. 09 of 2026 pending in the file of learned SDJM, Berhampur for commission of offences punishable U/Ss. 296/132/121(1) of BNS r/w Section 25(1-B)(a)/27 of the Arms Act, on the main allegation of possessing country made fire arm and live ammunitions as well as other weapons.

3. Heard, Mr. Sanjay Kumar Pradhan, learned counsel for the Petitioners in BLAPL No. 1472 of 2026; Ms. Swagatika Panda, learned counsel for the Petitioner in BLAPL No. 1852 of 2026 and Mr. P. Satpathy, learned Additional Public Prosecutor in the matter and perused the record.



4. After having considered the rival submissions and taking into consideration the nature and gravity of the offence as alleged against the petitioners vis-a-vis the accusations sought to be brought against them and regard being had to the pre-trial detention of the petitioners in custody since 08.01.2026 and there being no criminal antecedent of similar nature reported against the Petitioners and keeping in view the other circumstances on record in entirety including the inherent right of the accused to be presumed innocent until proven guilty at the trial, this Court without expressing any view on merits admits the Petitioners to bail.

5. Hence, these two bail applications of the petitioners namely Bhagaban Bishoyi @ Bisoyi, Prasanta Gajendra @ Tamago & Kanhu Charan Jena in BLAPL Nos. 1472 & 1852 of 2026 are allowed and each of the petitioners is allowed to go on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand) each with two solvent sureties each for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin of the case on such terms and conditions as deem fit and proper by it.

6. Accordingly, these BLAPL Nos. 1472 & 1852 of 2026 stand disposed of. Issue urgent certified copy of the order as per Rules. A soft copy of this order be immediately communicated to the concerned Court, who shall afterwards communicate the same to the concerned Jail through e-mail for reference.
