1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).

2. The appellant-petitioners have filed I.A. No. 367 of 2026 under Rule-22(2) of the Orissa Motor Vehicles (Accident Claims Tribunal) Rules, 1960 (in short, "the Rules") for exemption from paying of Court fee for time being.

3. Heard learned counsel for the appellants and perused the record.

4. For the reasons stated therein in the IA, the prayer for exemption of payment of Court fee for the time being stands allowed, but the appellants-petitioners are, however, required to pay the Court fee after disposal of this appeal. Accordingly, the I.A. No. 367 of 2026 stands disposed of.

5. The present Interlocutory Application in I.A. No. 368 of 2026 U/S.5 of the Limitation Act, 1963
