1. This CRLMP has been filed with the prayer to direct the Opposite Party No. 2 and 3 to conduct a fair and proper investigation with regard to the involvement of the accused persons in connection with Baliana PS Case No. 03 of 2026. It appears that Baliana PS Case No. 03 of 2026 has been registered under Section 296/308(2)/351(3)/3(5) of the BNS, where the petitioner is the informant.

2. Instructions dated 25.02.2026 of the IIC, Baliana Police Station is received, where it is stated as follows;

“With reference to above cited letter and subject. I have the honour to report that. I am submitting the progress of investigation of Baliana PS case No. 03/2026 are as follows:-

*“01. On the report of Complt Smt. Binodini Jena (29) W/o-
Siprasmit Jena of Vill- Benupur. of PS-Baliana Dist-*



Khurda Baliana PS case No. 03 dtd 05.01.2026 U/S- 296/351(3)/308(2)/3(5) BNS was registered and SI Baisalini Panda was entrusted to take up investigation of the case and on her transfer SI Kabita Nayak has been entrusted to take up investigation of the case.

02. The spot has been visited, the compit and other witness were examined and their statements have been recorded U/s- 180 BNSS.

03. The complt and her husband were advised to to produce transaction details regarding payment of Rs 17,00,000 (Seventeen lakh) to alleged person Lopamudra Das but they could not produce the same yet.

04. The alleged person Lopamudra Das has been examined and it is ascertained that the she has been working in administrative section of Narayani School, Pandara. Bhubanesawar. The daughter of complt namely Leyana Smith Jena was studying in this School. On dtd 26.04.2022 Siprasmita Jena, the husband of the compit had transferred Rs. 6800/- on her ICICI bank account-006101583384 (1) UPI for school books of her daughter and on the same day she transferred the said amount to Jagdish Jodapa, accountant of Narayana School (t) UPI. On dtd. 22.05.2023 he had transferred Rs. 6,000/- on her ICICI bank account-006101583384 (t) UPI for school fees of his daughter and she had transferred the said amount to the school account on 27.05.2023 (1) UPI She stated that she had not demanded any money from the husband of the complt. and further she stated that she will co-operate in investigation



of the case.

05. Requisition was sent to Branch Manager ICICI Bank, Rasulgarh branch Bhubaneswar to provide transaction details of A/c No-006101583384 stands in the name of Lopamudra Dash and as per my requisition BM, ICICI Bank, provided transaction details of A/c No-006101583384 stands in the name of Lopamudra Dash and it is ascertained that on did 26.04.2022 Siprasmita Jena had transferred Rs 6800/-, on ICICI bank account-006101583384 and on the same day she had transferred the said amount to Jagdish Jodapa, accountant of Narayana School. On dtd. 22.05.2023 Siprasmita Jena had transferred Rs. 6,000/-, on her ICICI bank account-006101583384 and she had transferred the said amount to Narayana junior School on 27.05.2023.

06. During verificatforye whats up chat in between the complt and alleged person Lopamudra Dus it is ascertained that there is exchange of chating of slang languages in between them.

07. On the written report of Lopamudra Das, Mancheswar PS case No- 62 dtd 27.01.2026 U/s- 296/7892)/308(5)/35193)/3(5) BNS have been registered against the petitioner and her husband Siprasmita Jena.

08. The C/A of the petitioner are as follows

3. It appears that investigation in the case is in progress, it also appears that the petitioner has six criminal antecedents.

4. In view of the instructions of the IIC, Baliana Police Station, I am not satisfied that any direction is required to be issued to her, regarding investigation of the case.

5. With this observation, the CRLMP is disposed of.
