01. 1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned counsel for the State.
2. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioners that the steps taken to construct the G.P. Bhawan of Digambarpur G.P. is patently violative of



the order dated 14.07.2017 passed by this Court in W.P.(C) No.14281 of 2008 at Annexure-6 and in terms of the leave granted by this Court as per order dated 04.02.2026 in W.P.(C). No.3353 of 2026, the present writ application has been filed.

3. On perusal of the report of the Revenue Inspector, prima facie it is seen that the construction of G.P. Bhawan is proposed at Digambarpur G.P. instead of Nuagarh, in terms of the order passed by this Court dated 14.07.2017 in W.P.(C). No.3533 of 2026, adverted to hereinabove and which has attained finality.

4. Issue notice to the Opposite Parties.

Since learned counsel for the State appears on behalf of the Opposite Parties 1 to 5, no further notice need be issued to the said Opposite Parties.

Notice be issued to the Opposite Party No.6 by Speed Post. Requisites shall be filed by 18.02.2026.

5. Learned counsel for the State is requested to obtain instruction.
