1. Sri Suryakanta Dash, learned Advocate for the petitioner drew attention of this Court to order dated 3rd January, 2025 passed under Section 6-D, Section 15(b) read with Section 25 (b) of the Odisha Survey and Settlement Act, 1958, wherein the Additional Commissioner, Additional Revision Court-I, Bhubaneswar having taken into consideration the report dated 09.12.2020 submitted by the Assistant Settlement Officer and Para-wise Report of Additional Tahasildar, Bhubaneswar *vide* letter No.11760 dated 25.07.2024 observed that an extent of Ac.0.070 decimal in Hal Plot No.1774 and Ac.0.030 decimal in Hal Plot No.1775 are in possession of the petitioner, yet in ultimate conclusion while the Tahasildar, Bhubaneswar is directed to record the said land measuring an area of Ac.0.070 decimal in Hal Khata No.1774 in favour of the petitioner, the other part for correction of ROR and map and the petitioner is directed to approach appropriate forum.



2. It is submitted that such a finding of fact and the direction are incongruous with the reports submitted by the Assistant Settlement Officer as well as the Additional Tahasildar on the basis of report submitted by the Revenue Inspector.
3. Issue notice.
4. Mr. Sanjay Rath, learned Additional Government Advocate appears and waives issue of notice on behalf of the opposite party nos.1 to 4 as copy of the writ petition has already been served on him.
5. Issue notice to the opposite party no.5 by Speed Post with A.D., requisites for which shall be filed within three working days. In the event of furnishing such requisites within the period stipulated, Office shall send the notice to the said opposite parties by fixing a short returnable date.
6. List this matter in the week commencing on 4th May, 2026.
