01. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. This I.A. has been filed by the petitioner in Review Petition No.47/2026 praying for exempting him from payment of Court Fees on the ground that, his annual income is less than one lakh.

3. In support of the same, he has filed his income certificate issued by the Revenue Officer on dated 18.02.2026 wherein his annual income has been shown as 70,000/- which is less than 1,00,000/-.

4. So, by applying the provisions of law envisaged in Section 35 of the Court Fees Act, 1870 and the notification of the Government of Odisha thereof, I find no justification to disallow the I.A. filed on behalf of the petitioner in order to exempt him from payment of Court Fees on the ground of his annual income is less than 1,00,000/-.



5. Hence, the I.A. is allowed.

6. The petitioner is exempted from paying the Court Fees in the Review Petition.

7. As such, this I.A. is disposed of finally.
