01. 1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
2. This I.A. has been filed by the Petitioner for condonation of delay of 245 days.
3. It is submitted that the Petitioner, under the bona fide belief that a petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. is maintainable against the impugned order of cognizance, had approached this Court and filed CRLMC No.5484 of 2025. The same was disposed of on 05.01.2026 giving liberty to the Petitioner to prefer the revision. Accordingly, this revision has been filed on 10.02.2026 and in the process there has been delay of about 245 days as pointed out by the SR.



4. Considering the reasons as stated, this court is persuaded to hold that sufficient cause has been shown for condonation of delay. Accordingly, the delay in filing of the CRLREV is condoned.

5. Accordingly, the I.A. stands disposed of.
