1. The CRLMP has been filed for quashing the entire proceeding and FIR in Gunupur P.S. Case No.248 of 2025, corresponding to G.R. Case No.428 of 2025 pending in the Court of the learned SDJM, Gunupur.

2. Gunupur P.S. Case No.248 of 2025 had been registered under Sections 69, 89, 351(3), 3(5) of the BNS on the basis of the FIR submitted by the victim-Opposite Party No.2.

3. On the last date i.e. 06.03.2026 it is stated by the learned counsel for the Petitioner that the Petitioner No.1 and Opposite Party No.2 has got married on 08.01.2026 for which the Opposite Party No.2 who was a major at the time of appearance, she did not want to

pursue the case since after marriage she is leading a happy conjugal life.

Learned Additional Standing Counsel had been directed to obtain instruction from the IIC Gunupur Police Station regarding the marriage of Petitioner No.1 and Opposite Party No.2 and whether Opposite Party No.2 is staying in the house of the Petitioner No.1 and they are leading a happy conjugal life and whether she has been accepted as a wife of the Petitioner No.1 by other family members.

5. Though instruction has been received from the IIC, Gunupur Police Station, Mr. S.K. Tripathy, learned counsel for the Petitioners files a memo stating that the Petitioners do not want to proceed with the present case for which the same may be permitted to be withdrawn.

6. Considering the said submission and the memo, the CRLMP is dismissed as withdrawn.
