This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

- 2.** Learned Counsel for the Petitioner is present.
- 3.** Though, pursuant to order dated 24.02.2020, notice was issued to the Opposite Party by Registered Post with A.D., as per the office note, neither A.D. nor undelivered notice as against the sole Opposite Party yet received.
- 4.** Hence, in view of the provisions enshrined under sub-rule 5 of rule 9 under order 5 of CPC, read with Section 27 of the General Clauses Act, 1897, notice on the sole Opposite Party is held to be sufficient.
- 5.** On being asked, learned counsel for the Petitioner submits, CP No.945 of 2019 is still pending.
- 6.** However, to give further opportunity to the Opposite Party, office is directed to communicate a copy of this order to the learned Judge, Family Court, Bhubaneswar, who shall do well to communicate the



same either to the Opposite Party, who is the Petitioner in CP No.945 of 2019 or his Counsel, who represents him in the said proceeding and report compliance before the next date of listing.

7. Learned Court below shall also furnish the present status of CP No.945 of 2019 along with the compliance report.

8. The matter be listed in the week commencing from 23rd February, 2026.

9. Interim order passed earlier shall continue till the next date, subject to the pendency of C.P. No.945 of 2019 before the learned Judge, Family Court, Bhubaneswar.
