This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. Learned Counsel for the Petitioner is present.

3. Pursuant to order dated 09.01.2026, vide which a direction was given to the learned Court below to communicate a copy of the said order to the present Opposite Party or his Counsel, who represents him in CP No.945 of 2019, the learned Court below has communicated vide Letter No.124 dated 16.02.2026 that neither the present Opposite Party (Petitioner before the Court below) nor his amicus curiae had attended the Court proceedings since long.

4. That apart, there is no contact number of the Petitioner in the petition as well as in the Vakalatnama of the amicus curiae. Hence copy of the said order could not be served personally on any of them.

5. However, a copy of the said order was sent to the Opposite Party (Petitioner before Court below) by Registered Post, enclosing thereto a copy of the order passed by this



Court. Despite such communication, the Petitioner did not appear before the Court below, even though notice was served at his permanent address. So far as the present address, the same is yet to be delivered.

6. At this stage, learned Counsel for the Petitioner renders no instruction and files a memo to the said effect in the Court. The memo filed in the Court be kept on record.
