It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the revision petition under Section 6-D, Section 15(b) read with Section 25(b) of the Odisha Survey & Settlement Act, 1958 was filed at the behest of one Urmila Ugrasen Singh showing opposite party no.4 as Sashikala Behera disclosing as wife of "Bhagyadhar Mohanty". Referring to Annexure-3, *i.e.* plaint filed by said Urmila Ugrasen Singh in C.S. No.1712 of 2022 before the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Bhubaneswar it is submitted that Sasikala Behera is described as the daughter of "Bijaya Ketan Behera" as one of the defendants. It is further submitted that in the mutation Record of Right (Annexure-2), the husband of Sasikala Behera is disclosed as "Bijaya Ketan Behera" but not "Bhagyadhar Mohanty". He therefore contended that playing fraud and misguiding the Court, the opposite party nos.3 and 4 could manage to suppress fact and notice being not served on proper person, the



order dated 21.07.2023 has been passed by the Additional Commissioner, Additional Revision Court-IV which caused prejudice to the petitioner. It is asserted that no notice has ever been served on the petitioner before passing the order in revision in OSS Case No.680 of 2022 by the Additional Commissioner, Additional Revision Court-IV, Odisha, Bhubaneswar.

4. Mr. Sanjay Rath, learned Additional Government Advocate appears and waives issue of notice on behalf of the opposite party nos.1 and 2 as a copy of the writ petition has already been served on him.

5. Issue notice to the opposite party nos.3 to 6 by Speed Post with A.D., requisites for which shall be filed within three working days. In the event of furnishing such requisites within the period stipulated, Office shall send the notice to the said opposite parties by fixing a short returnable date.

6. Issue notice as above.

7. Accept one set of process fee.

8. List this matter in the week commencing on 4th May, 2026.
