1. This is an application by the petitioner-Siva Shankar Dash @ Pintu for grant of interim bail to him for surgical intervention of his wife.

2. Heard, Mr. Haripada Mohanty, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Partha Sarathi Nayak, learned specially engaged counsel for the State in the matter



and perused the record together with the written instruction received from SDPO Berhampur Town as produced.

3. After having considered the rival submissions and on going through the materials placed on record together with the documents as produced, since the petitioner is an alleged history-sheeter and there being other persons available in the family for the treatment of his wife, this Court does not consider it proper to grant interim bail to the petitioner.

Hence, the present application for grant of interim bail to the petitioner stands rejected.

4. Hence, the IA stands dismissed.
