01. 1. Heard Mr. R.K. Mahalik, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. T.K. Dash, learned AGA.
2. The grievance of the petitioner is that his petition for final decree proceeding in T.S. No.49 of 1987 is not accepted by the court of learned Senior Civil Judge, Chhatrapur.
3. As seen from the copy of the decree produced by Mr. Mahalik, learned counsel for the petitioner, that the decree is dated 18th December, 1992 for performance of specific contract, i.e. to execute the sale deed within a period of two months from the date of the decree. It is further seen from the contents of the revisional order dated 3rd February, 2016 of the court of learned 1st A.D.J., Chhatrapur in Civil Revision petition No.2 of 2013 (Annexure-1 series) that, present petitioner has filed Execution Proceeding No.35 of 2002 which has been disposed of finally during pendency of the revision petitioner and the case record has been destroyed.



4. Thus considering all such facts, no merit is seen in present prayer of the petitioner to present any final decree proceeding before the concerned court, which is not maintainable.

5. Accordingly the writ petition is dismissed.
