1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).

2. This is a bail application U/S.483 of BNSS by the petitioner for grant of bail in connection with Dharakote PS Case No.230 of 2024 corresponding to GR Case No.1289 of 2024 pending in the file of learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Aska, Ganjam for commission of offences punishable U/Ss.331(4)/ 309(4)/ 127(6)/ 238/ 53/ 317(2) BNS r/w Sec.25(1(a) / 27 of the Arms Act.

The allegation against the Petitioner is that three unknown persons committed robbery in the shop of the informant on gun point and took away 3 Kg of gold, 8 Kg of Silver and Cash of Rupees Two Lakhs Twenty Seven Thousand along with four golden finger rings & one Vivo Mobile phone, whose approximate cost would be around Rupees Two Crore Seventy Lakhs as per the informant by tying his mouth and hand and subsequently, the investigation unearthed the involvement of the Petitioner in this case.

3. Heard, Mr. Debasish Patnaik, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. R.B. Mishra, learned Addl. Public



Prosecutor in the matter and perused the record including the copy of depositions of PW1-8.

4. After having considered the rival submission and on going through the materials placed on record keeping in view the evidence of the witnesses so far examined, more particularly that of PW.1 and the petitioner having been allegedly identified in the trial by PW1 to be one of the perpetrators of the crime, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

5. Hence, the bail application of the petitioner stands rejected. Accordingly, the BLAPL stands disposed of.
